VM Normal Body Review Folder: Clicking the FINAL REVIEW link on the histology website will bring you to a VM Normal Body Review Folder (towards the bottom of the page) which contains slides of organs that are not labeled. In preparation for the Final exam, a good review exercise is to try to identify these organs, writing down the key characteristics of each organ. Working with a colleague can be helpful, and ask your instructor for help if you have trouble with identification. The answer key for the unknown slides is printed on the next page of this manual.
